



What You Need To Know About Registration



Arrival Time

Registration is required before any services can begin. Please allow 30 minutes to complete the registration process prior to your scheduled arrival time.



What To Bring With You

1. A prescription or order form from your doctor that indicates the test you are having and your diagnosis. (Please Note) The physicians order must be signed not stamped.
2. Insurance Cards.
3. Driver's license or other proof of address and identification.
4. Referral form is required and/or authorization number. It is the responsibility of the patient to provide the referral to the hospital.
5. If workers compensation or motor vehicle accident, the patient must bring the claim number, insurance name, address, phone number, contact person at the insurance company and the original date of loss.



Know Your Insurance Coverage

To help speed up the process, please check with your insurance company to be sure that we are the correct in-network facility for your desired test. Make sure to ask if a co-payment will be required. It is important to check with your insurance provider to see if you will need a referral and/or authorization number for all tests.



Payment

1. If required by your insurance, you will be responsible to make a co-payment at the time of service.
2. If you have no insurance coverage, payment for services is due at the time of registration.
